# TAOS, NEW MEXICO

**MOUNTAIN FACTS:** With 300" of annual snowfall and over 110 trails the mountain has 24% beginner, 24% intermediate and 52% expert runs. With plenty of skier capacity, the lifts are seldom crowded. Snowboarders were allowed for the first time in 2009. Taos is a living postcard surrounding you with vistas that spell adventure. Southwest history and culture are abundant here. The 1000 year old Taos Pueblo is an adobe Indian village that is now a World Heritage site. St. Francisco de Asis in downtown Taos is the most painted church in America. 30% of the residents of Taos are artisans. Museums and galleries cover this area.

**LODGING:** The deluxe Sierra Del Sol condos are located 75 yards from the ski lift and in the center of Taos Ski Valley village near the shops and restaurants. We have booked two- 2 bedroom condos and five- 2 bedroom condos with lofts. The master bedroom has a queen bed, the second bedroom has a queen or two twins, and the loft has two twins. There are two baths. The condos have full kitchens, coffee makers, TV/DVD, a common hot tub and sauna, high speed internet. Some rooms have fireplaces and balconies. Hair dryers are available on request. Maximum occupancy is 6 in the 2 bedroom units and 8 in the loft units. Use of the sleeper sofa, if available, would be necessary to reach maximum occupancy.
